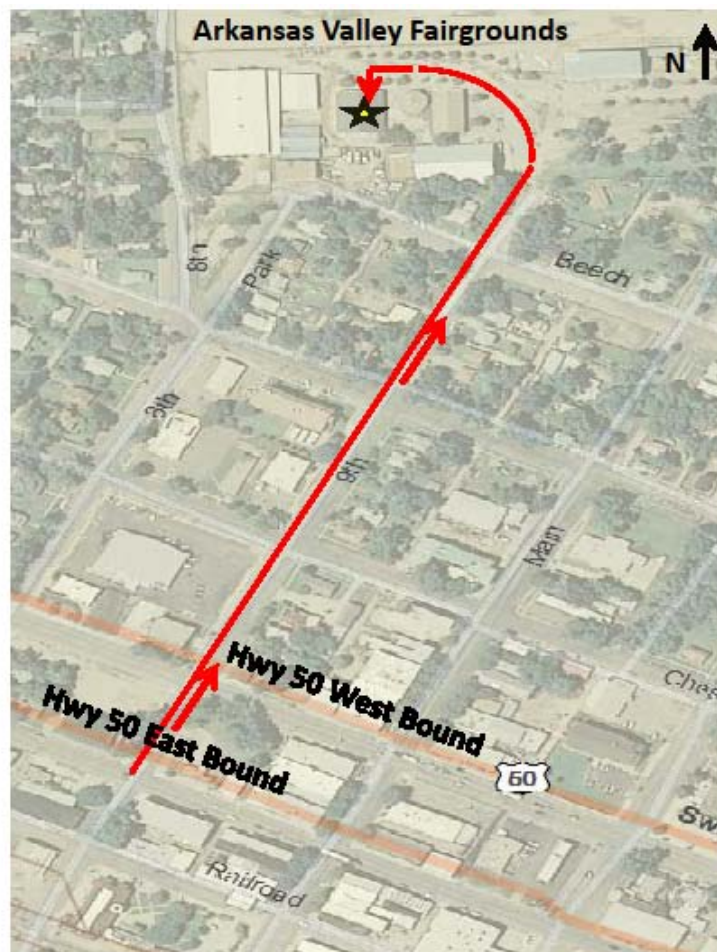

- Rocky Ford is located in Southeastern Colorado in Otero County along the Hwy 50 corridor
- Rocky Ford is approximately 60 miles southeast of Pueblo, CO
- Once within the city limits of Rocky Ford on Hwy 50, turn northeast on 9th Street
- Travel approximately 3 blocks northeast to the Fairgrounds
- Enter the grounds through the large gates
- You will pass two large buildings on the left upon entering the grounds
- Once past these buildings, turn west and follow the road for ~30 yards to the events center; the conference will be held here
