Program:

The National Carbon Offset Coalition (NCOC), a Montana based nonprofit corporation and an aggregating member of the Chicago Climate Exchange (CCX) the world's first and North America's only carbon credit trading platform, are now accepting urban forestry based carbon offsets for placement into the market. The program will cover information on carbon sequestration, the carbon market in general, specific urban forestry application procedures, contracting, trading procedures, and offset pricing.
