AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALIDA, COLORADO, AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE SALIDA MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City has established a Tree Board whose duties include recommending practices and associated costs for the care, preservation, trimming, planting, replanting, removal or disposition of street and park tree; and

WHEREAS, at their March 11, 2014 meeting, the Tree Board members expressed they would be in favor of changing the Salida Municipal Code to allow for medium sized trees to be planted in existing parkways of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Salida City Council finds and determines that the best interests of the citizens of Salida will be served by amending Chapter 11 of the Salida Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SALIDA, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1</u>. The aforementioned recitals are hereby fully incorporated herein.

Section 2. Section 11-5-10 (d) of the Salida Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows, with changes shown in bold, double-underlined text and deletions in strikethrough text.

(d) Distance from curbs, sidewalks, and corners. The distance that trees may be planted from curbs or curb lines and sidewalks will be in accordance with the three (3) size classes, and no trees may be planted closure to any curb or sidewalk than the following:

Small <u>or medium</u> trees 2: Medium trees 3: Large trees 4:
