9-930am: Aaron Sincoular with Supertrees will give a presentation chat about SuperTrees' nursery and the process for growing/digging trees is different than other nursery stock we see. They have found a niche for providing trees for nonprofits and working with municipal urban forestry departments to accomplish their specific goals. Whether it is tree planting or structural pruning, their team of ISA certified arborists provide services to directly contribute to enhancing tree canopy within cities and neighborhoods of Colorado.

930-1000am: Kamie Long with CO State Forest Service. Kamie will present on the Inflation Reduction Act grant funds that Colorado received. The presentation will explain who is eligible to apply, what types of projects can be funded, how to apply and the timeline of the grant.

1000-1030am: Adam Moore with CO State Forest Service will give a presentation on COWRAP - Colorado Wildfire Risk Assessment Portal - This online portal can support the community wildfire protection planning needs of government officials, hazard mitigation planners, and wildland fire professionals. The key features of this application include the capability to define a project area, generate a detailed risk summary report, and export and download wildfire risk GIS data. This can be very useful to communities that have wildland urban interface, which is a lot in the intermountain west!
