Sec. 7-1013. - Park trees—Planting, cutting.

(a)

It is unlawful for any person, other than duly authorized city personnel, to plant or transplant, or to allow the planting or transplanting of, trees or any other vegetative material within any park property.

(b)

It is unlawful for any person, other than duly authorized city personnel, to top, trim, prune or in any way cut any park trees without first obtaining written authorization from the city.

(c)

It is unlawful for any person to intentionally damage park trees by any means or to attach ropes, wire, nails, advertising posters or other contrivance to park trees without first obtaining written authorization from the city.

(d)

It is unlawful for any person to allow any gaseous liquid or solid substance that is harmful to park trees to come in contact with them or to set fire to, or permit any fire to burn when such fire or the heat thereof will injure, any portion of any park trees.
